

# **EXAMPLE OF AN ILLEGAL LEGAL PLATE**

There are many formats or styles of plate that are illegal, here is an example of some of the most common lllegal plates can result in a £1,000 fine for the owner



## **IDENTIFIER**

Only the authorised flags and identifiers are legal - they cannot be replaced by alternative images

## **BORDER**

The border can only be up to 6mm wide and cannot touch the identifier

## TRADE NAME

Only the name, address and postcode of the supplier is allowed on the plate, and in a space no larger than 178mm x 13mm

## REFLECTIVE/SUBSTRATE

Poor quality substrate can result in bleaching. The reflective materials used must meet all the retro-reflective markings and optical requirements of BSAU 145d.

## BRITISH STANDARD

A missing British Standard manufacturers' mark on the bottom right side of the plate indicates that the plate doesn't meet the British Standard requirement

## **BACKGROUND**

No patterns or decoration is permitted in the background

# CHARACTER SPACING

Spacing is strictly controlled on legal plates, moving the spacing is not allowed

#### ALTERING LETTERING

Using fixings or other methods to suggest an alternative character is not allowed

#### CHARACTER FONT

Anything other that the standard authorised font in its original form is not allowed
